R E D W I N E S

Mesta – Tempranillo, Organic, Castilla, Spain – 14 %

Vibrant and juicy, unoaked Tempranillo showing great purity and typicity from high altitude vines. Expressive aromas of red berries, rosemary, and a touch of liquorice are echoed on the fresh, rounded palate.

Stone Elephant – Monastrell, Murcia, Spain – 14%

Superb example of Monastrell, with its powerful and intense nose of ripe black fruits supported by subtle hints of spice from a deft use of oak. The vibrant fruit is rounded out with a savoury note and it shows great purity on the finish

Bideona “Mayela” Rioja, Alavesa, 2023 – Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain – 13.5% *Pure*

and intense aromas of dark cherries and blackberries are layered with a hint of violet and clove. The concentrated fruit is beautifully balanced by a fresh palate with chiselled, chalky tannins and a long, mineral finish.

Milu, Quinta Milu – Tempranillo, Organic growing, Ribera del Duero, Spain 13.5%

Aromas of ripe dark fruits, black cardamom, licorice and peppery spices. Bright and pure, with great acidity and supple tannins

Krontiras Mikron – Maipu, Mendoza, Malbec – 13.5% / Biodynamic With no aging in oak barrels, this early-drinking young Malbec fermented and aged in stainless steel recreates the concept of a Beaujolais Nouveau style, a red wine created to be consumed chilled, at white wine temperature. A dangerously drinkable bright, perfumed medium-weight red with succulent, refreshing blueberry and red cherry fruit. A refreshingly different take on this grape.

Sus Scrofa, Celler Pardas – Sumoll, Organic & Natural, Penedès, Catalunya – 12%

Sus

Scrofa is a lighter style of red, similar to a Pinot Noir but with the structure of a Nebbiolo. Red fruits and lavender aromas underlying Mediterranean dried herbs and wet chalk.

Black Slate Escaladei, La Conreira D'Scala Dei – Garnatxa & Carignan, Organic, Priorat, Catalunya – 14.5%

Exudes classic Priorat aromas of black cherries and bramble fruit with notes of baked slate, licorice root and wild herbs. Medium to full-bodied, fresh, and focused palate with a lengthy finish

Cosecheros de Labastida “Saigoba Jorge Gil” 2020 – Moscatel, Viura, Garnacha, Tempranillo, Rioja, Spain – 14%

Vivid fruity nose with spice, refined body, oak well integrated. Elegant, expressive Rioja. Medium-bodied, silky, vibrant.

Aged for 12 months in oak barrels ("12 meses en barrica"), contributing structure and depth.

R O S É W I N E

Château de Campuget 'Le Campuget' Syrah, Grenache Rosé 2024 – Languedoc, France – 12%

A delicate pale pink rosé with enticing aromas of fresh wild strawberries and hints of grapefruit. Refreshing with a persistent finish, completed by subtle hints of nectarine. Simply delicious.

O R A N G E W I N E

Ancestrolopitecus Bodegas Parra Jimenez 2024, Verdejo 100 %, La Mancha, Spain / Skin contact, vegan, Biodynamic

Subtle vanilla and spice along with delicate aromas of peach and orange are complimented by savoury, peppery notes on the palate. Lees aging helps round out the wine, creating a smooth and complex finished wine. Made from biodynamically farmed Verdejo grapes.

P E T N A T

Criolla Argentina – Criollas 2023, Mendoza, Argentina – 12.5 % (low intervention, unfiltered)

It's a pet-nat made from native Argentine Criolla grapes. A low intervention and unfiltered wine with citrus and fruity aromas – peach, jasmine, and pear. Small, persistent bubbles. A dry finish with good length. Medium, natural acidity.

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W H I T E W I N E S

Renegado 2023 – Macabeo 80 %, Moscatel 20 % Valencia, Spain – 12%

Bright and aromatic aromas of white fruits and delicate floral notes lead to a refreshing and beautifully balanced palate, with a vibrant fruit character and a crisp finish.

Nivarius 2024 – Tempranillo Blanco, Rioja, Spain – 13.5%

Refreshing with a creamy texture and fruity notes of zesty citrus and stone fruits are complemented by white floral blossom and mineral nuances. Showing beautiful balance through to a long finish.

Finca Cobaltos 2024 – Godello, Galicia, Spain – 13%

A highly aromatic wine showing zesty citrus aromas combined with ripe stone fruits, a mineral sensation and hint of white pepper. Dry with a refreshing crisp palate of pineapple, tropical fruits and a delicious, dry, citrus finish.

Cucú, Barco del Corneta – Verdejo, Organic, Castilla y León, Spain – 13.5%

A fresh and delightful young wine, bursting with bright citrus zests, bitter melon, herbs, and cool mineral nuance.

Bico da Ran, Fento Wines – Albariño, Rías Baixas, Galicia, Spain – 13%

There is plenty of Albariño typicity here, with citrus fruits, fennel and passion fruit on the nose. On the palate it is fruity but fresh, with good intensity and length.

Flower and the Bee, Coto de Gomariz – Treixadura, Organic, Ribeiro, Spain – 13.5%

Powerful flavours of herbs, pears and white peach, with some apricot and spice notes. Real presence, but not at all heavy. Just lovely fruit intensity, and amazing freshness.

Viticulture is organic. Many Biodynamic practices are used.

David Fernández “Mancha Blanca” 2023 – Listán Blanco, Organic & Natural, Lanzarote, Spain – 12%

Green apple, lemon zest, saline minerality, herbal tones, flint. Crisp and salty finish. Natural, unfiltered, volcanic
